

Here are few updates and some general information about the Medical Centre and the team working here...

Face masks

Masks are no longer mandatory for patients and staff at the medical centre. However, if you are displaying any cold/flu symptoms we ask that you do still wear one whilst in the practice. Masks will still be available at the reception for patients who need or wish to wear one.





Recording home blood pressure readings

If you are asked to record your blood pressure at home, the doctors have put together a formatted sheet for you to easily record your results. Any readings that are not recorded on this sheet will not be accepted as they can often be difficult to read and interpret.

If you are not able to collect a form before doing your readings, you can make a note of them and transfer them onto the new sheet when you bring them into surgery.

Travel Vaccinations

If you are needing vaccinations before travelling abroad, please make sure they are booked in good time. We only offer NHS vaccines (polio, typhoid, hepatitis A and cholera).





Appts used and missed - S1 rep

Between 1st Feb and 1st March, we had **124 booked appointments that were not attended**. Missed appointments could have been used for other patient and have huge financial implications for the NHS. If you are unable to attend your appointment for any reason, please let us know.

NHS Help with Health Costs – HRT prepayment prescriptions

If you pay for NHS prescribed HRT medicine 3 or more times a year, a HRT prepayment certificate could save you money. As you know, each item on an NHS prescription would usually cost you £9.65. However, you can now purchase a HRT PPC for a one-off payment of £19.30 (the cost of two single items). This certificate would allow you collect an unlimited number of certain HRT medicines for free for 12 months, regardless of why they are prescribed.

Please be aware that the certificate **DOES NOT** cover all HRT medicines



If you feel you may need to see a physio, appointments can either be face to face if there is capacity, or over the or phone for an initial assessment. If a patient calls and the receptionist feels they may benefit from seeing/speaking to the physio, they will direct you to Rachel. Unfortunately, Rachel is unable to see patients under 16 or patients that already have a diagnosed medical issue such as Rheumatoid Arthritis, she is also unable to visit housebound patients.
